

## Museum Pass Rules

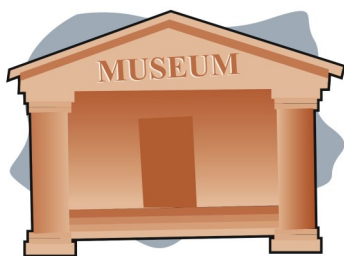
Museum passes are a service provided by the Parsippany-Troy Hills Public Library System that enables customers to visit several museums.

It's a great way for friends and families residing in Parsippany to enjoy education, cultural enrichment, and fun.

All Parsippany-Troy Hills resident cardholders, **in good standing**, are **eligible** to check out a museum pass.

Passes are on a first come, first served basis. We want as many residents as possible to have the chance to use our museum passes. So please remember:

1. Only one museum pass may be borrowed at a time.
2. Bring the pass back after your museum visit, so that other families have the opportunity to borrow it.

- You can only return the pass to the Main Library
- If pass is lost, there is a \$100 replacement fee.



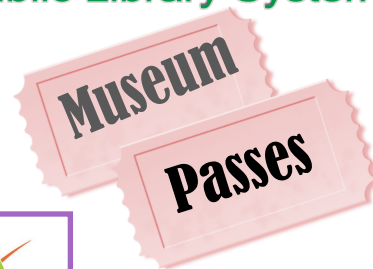
