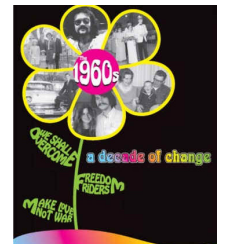

### Dr. Robert Butts



Maestro Robert W. Butts, founder and conductor of the Baroque Orchestra of New Jersey for 20 years, was named one of five 2015 Honored Artists by The American Prize.

Dr. Butts is a faculty member at Montclair State University and Drew University. He lectures in many venues including conferences, adult education programs, and educational panels at the Metropolitan Opera.

As well as being a gifted lecturer, Dr. Butts is a renowned conductor. In addition to his ongoing commitment to the Baroque Orchestra of New Jersey, he has conducted numerous opera companies in the NJ/NY area. Finally, Dr. Butts's compositions have been performed in Europe and Asia.
